**Interview Process:** Interviews will be conducted in September 2024. The CIG faculty will select which candidate(s) to support for the grant applications shortly after the interviews.

**Support Provided:** The successful grantees will receive support from the CIG, including research space, access to technical platforms in genomics, proteomics, and imaging, necessary animal housing, logistics and administrative support, and the possibility of an additional year's salary beyond the five-year funding period of the grant.
